On Saturday, April 10, 2021 by 7AM, any resident** may put out curbside **any large, bulky waste items**, [regular garbage, hazardous materials, construction debris, commercial business items, appliances, tires, "e-waste" or yard wastes will not be accepted]. The location for your curbside pickup will be where you normally put your garbage totes for pickup.

OCTOBER 9, 2021 DUMPSTER CLEAN-UP

CITY-WIDE CLEAN UP DAY - FREE DISPOSAL!! - SATURDAY, OCTOBER 9, 2021-

On Saturday, October 9, 2021 between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., any resident** may bring **large, bulky waste items, appliances, and tires**, [regular garbage, hazardous materials, construction debris, commercial business items, "e-waste" or yard wastes will not be accepted] to the Waste Water Treatment Plant at 1800 Iowa Drive during the hours mentioned above. City public works employees will be present to verify residency and to assist with your disposal efforts.

** Only LeClaire residents with proof of residency (no commercial businesses) whose City garbage accounts are paid in full may participate in the Clean-ups. For more information or if you have any questions or special needs, please feel free to call City Hall at 289-4242.

"E-waste" is defined as devices that contain a circuit board or a cathode ray tube such as, computer monitors, TVs, VCRs, stereos, computers, radios, and video game systems. E-waste contains environmental hazards such as lead, mercury, cadmium, nickel, chromium, lithium, and PCBs.
